SACRAMENTO REGIONAL GROUP #4's CHALLENGE

Over the years our Regional Group has purchased and otherwise accumulated tables, chairs, banners, swap meet signs, and striping equipment, in addition to BBQ and picnic supplies, all necessary for necessary Club events. Disposition of the items in our Clubs "stash" between events has depended on the willingness of then current Club Officers and supportive members to offer storage space at their private residences. It has been difficult to keep track of our "stash inventory" when thus distributed, let alone rounding up needed items for an upcoming Club event.

After considerable discussion focused on the Board of Directory responsibility for the safekeeping and availability of the Club's proposes the following:

That our Regional Group purchase an 8' by 10' enclosed trailer for storage and transporting of Club property only. The cost of purchasing such a trailer will be no more than \$2,500. The Club would maintain the annual cost of insurance and license fees, The storage location of the trailer would be maintained by the membership.

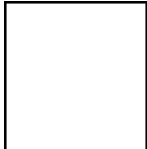
